Catholic Charities Archdiocese of New Orleans, Immigration Legal Services is holding free community legal orientations each month. These legal orientations will provide information based on what is already known on who may qualify for deferred action ("DACA" and "DAPA"), as well as how to prepare for a future application for deferred action.

Community orientations are being held in Metairie, New Orleans, New Orleans East, & the Westbank.

Please call and leave a message providing your full name, phone number, and/or email address. Once you leave a message, Immigration Services will contact you to pre-register you for one of our orientation sessions. Space is limited, so advance registration is required and will be granted on a first-come first-served basis. Please be patient as it may take us longer than usual to respond to everyone.

Catholic Charities will also be assisting low-income individuals to prepare and submit applications for deferred action once these forms of relief become available in February and May 2015. You must attend a group orientation before you will be able to schedule an individual consultation with Catholic Charities in the future to review your eligibility for deferred action.
