### ORDER OF INFO TIPS

The **17 church parishes** in St. Tammany and Washington Parishes are listed first.

They are and are **highlighted in blue**.

All other organizations are then listed in **alphabetical order**.

Please note that there are **3 tabs at the bottom**: Resource List, Affordable Housing, and VIA LINK #s.

Click once on the tab below to access the information described.

You may have to click on "view" on the upper toolbar and select "full screen" to see the bottom tabs.

To remove full screen, just right click on top of document, and right click and close "full Screen"

### HOW TO USE RESOURCE LIST SPREADSHEET/TAB

The **color coding** was designed for visual ease while scrolling down the document.

The **types of services** are listed at the top **diagonally**.

The organizations are listed in the column to the left.

The org. names that are in **blue and underlined** include a **hyperlink** to their website. Click once to open.

A "**X**" indicates that the organization on the left provides the type of service listed at the top.

The **types of services remain at the top** of the spreadsheet as you scroll through the names.

**If you need to locate an organization by name:**

-just scroll down or page down the spreadsheet to view the organizations by name.

**If you have a type or service (s) needed:**

-just find the service category in the diagonal slot, then scroll down or page down to "X".

-the color columns will assist in staying in the correct column during scrolling.

**When you locate an "X", then look to the left to identify the organizations that provides the service.**

**Organizations have contact info and more contact/service details are in the far right column.**
