## 2020 SUGGESTIONS:

- ★ **Food Basket** ~ Christmas – include gift card for turkey/ham – No Perishables Please!
- ★ **Food Pantry Donation** – Any non-expired non-perishables are welcome to help our food pantry. The food pantry was established in May to respond to the COVID crisis, and continues to assist families in need by providing a bag of non-perishable groceries each month. These will have a Metairie drop off location.
- ★ **Adopt-An-Angel** ~ purchase a gift for a child/adult in one of our programs
- ★ **Adopt-A-Family** ~ brighten a family's Christmas with new clothing, gifts, household goods, food
- ★ **Help with Health ~ HIGH PRIORITY!** Help our seniors, clients struggling with homelessness, and food pantry clients feel and look their best with hygiene items; each health bag should consist of regular size shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, floss, and deodorant, with the option to add other items as desired – aftershave, perfume, lotion, conditioner, washcloth etc. Please put in a gift bag or reusable tote bag and specify mens or womens.
- ★ **Kids Health Bag** ~ help our clients 8 and under with fun hygiene items! Each bag should include child's toothpaste and toothbrush, comb, shampoo, soap and a book in a reusable bag (no gift bags please). Optional items include: bubble bath or bath bombs, lotion, bath toys, washcloth, etc. Please specify girl or boy.
- ★ **Christmas Baby Shower** ~ Help our pro-life programs support families with new babies and small children this holiday season! Items needed include teething rings, rattles, books, small toys (ages 4 and under), diapers (larger sizes 4-6 and pull ups), wipes, baby bath items (baby wash/baby towels), clothing (3 mos- 5T), socks, bibs and bottles. What a great way to celebrate Jesus coming to earth as a baby!
