MIGRANT RIGHTS: EDUCATION

You have the right...

To a free, fair and equal education

- All children present in the U.S. have the right to enroll in a public school until 18 years of age - regardless of race, language, disability, country of origin, immigration status, or whether they live in temporary housing or are homeless. In most cases, youth over 18 may still enroll in public school if they are able to graduate by the time they turn 21.
- All children have the right to enroll in school immediately upon request – even if the child does not have all requested documentation.
- You have the right to enroll in public adult education programs if you are over the age of 18 – regardless of nation of origin.
- All children have the right to a free evaluation if there is suspicion of a learning or behavior disability.

To accessible communication

- Parents have the right to receive all schoolrelated documents and information in their preferred language.
- Parents have the right to a free professional interpreter provided by the school for all communication with the school as needed.
- Students and parents have the right to receive the school manual in their preferred language.
- Parents have the right to receive immediate notification if their child is at risk of failing their grade level.
- Students have the right to have their level of English regularly and formally evaluated in school.

To protect your student

- You have the right to communicate directly with administrators regarding any problem the student is facing in school, and to question disciplinary actions taken against your child.
- You have the right to report any violation of rights and/or instances of racism or discrimination.

• Your child has the right to refuse to serve as an interpreter for a parent or anyone else.

To privacy and confidentiality

- Your immigration status is private information. No school or teacher should ever request information on the student or family's immigration status/documents.
- Schools must keep all student information private unless the family consents to sharing.

*Information shared about the student in a school directory can be omitted at the family's request.
