MONEY MATTERS is a United Way of St. Charles Community Impact Program.

The goal of the **UWSC Money Matters Financial Stability Program** is to address the on-going needs of individuals and families in St. Charles Parish and help them attain greater self-sufficiency and independence. A long-term Community Case Manager works directly with clients to assess their needs and to develop a plan of care that coaches clients in developing skills and other resources needed to reduce their dependence on emergency services.

Through partnerships with local agencies, the **UWSC Money Matters Financial Stability Program** can help with needs such as:

- Medicaid application assistance
- SNAP (food stamps) assistance
- Food Banks/Clothing referral
- Battered Women Services
- Housing assistance (Fire Victims and Domestic Violence Victims)
- Short-term shelter assistance

- Medical equipment assistance (minimum assistance)
- Financial Counseling (Spending plan or Budgeting)
- Financial Workshops
- Mental Health Counseling referral
- Legal assistance referral
- Financial assistance (minimum and case by case)

Please note any financial assistance of any kind is evaluated on a case by case basis.
